All information submitted will become the property of TAMACC and documents such as notebooks, resumes, photographs, portfolios, etc. **will not be returned**. Please retain copies of any information needed for future use.

The Awards Selection Committee will select the final award recipients. Entries will be judged using the criteria specified and consideration may also include the quality and relevance of the materials submitted. The awardees will be selected based solely on this nomination package as provided and decided by an anonymous Selection Committee of established community and business leaders.

Nominees must agree to attend the event the award will be presented at the 43rd Annual Hispanic Business Convention of Texas September 6 – 8, 2018 in San Marcos, Texas. Two (2) complimentary tickets will be provided to the recipient for the event the award is presented.

Businesswoman presentation is during the Latina Empowerment Luncheon on Friday, September 7, 2018. All other posted awards will be presented at the Chairman's Gala and Awards Banquet on Saturday, September 8, 2018.

2018 TAMACC Annual Awards – Criteria

One (1) original and two (2) copies of the complete nomination packet must be submitted per nominee per category. These copies will be utilized by the Awards Selection Committee during the review process. All information submitted will become the property of TAMACC and documents such as notebooks, resumes, photographs, portfolios, etc. **will not be returned**. Please retain copies of any information needed for future use.

Information in nomination packet should be submitted in the order shown below.

The criterion for TAMACC Member Chamber/Organization of the Year is as follows:

1. Chamber/Organization must be a current member in good standing of TAMACC.
2. Chamber/Organization participation in TAMACC activities such as quarterly meetings, annual convention, and legislative events, will greatly be considered. Please describe and/or document activity and participation with TAMACC.
3. Provide a description of the Chamber/Organization's Program of Work, including major activities, services to members, advocacy on behalf of members and/or Hispanic business, and major economic development or procurement programs/projects which benefit members.
4. Provide newspaper clippings, magazines, or other articles and/or publications which show media coverage of Chamber/Organization's programs and activities.
5. Describe how your Chamber/Organization maintains membership, corporate partnerships and sponsorships.
6. Describe two (2) innovative programs/projects which your Chamber/Organization has initiated.
7. Submit a list of other major accomplishments.
8. Submit a high-resolution logo in .jpg format e-mailed to panton@tamacc.org.

The criterion for Businesswoman or Businessman of the Year is as follows:

1. Nominee must be Hispanic.
2. Nominee must be an owner of a business. Please provide the best documentation available which shows the ownership.
3. Nominee's business must be a current (paid) member of a local Chamber and/or Organization which is a member in good standing of TAMACC. The nominee must submit a letter from their Chamber/Organization stating that the nominee is a member in good standing.
4. Provide a description of their business.
5. Submit a description of the nominee's active involvement in Chamber/Organization work, Hispanic business community and/or community involvement.



6. Submit a list of major accomplishments, honors, awards and/or recognitions received by the nominee.
7. Provide a biography of the nominee.
8. Submit a 5 x 7 professional quality glossy headshot photograph. In addition, submit a high-resolution headshot in .jpg format e-mailed to panton@tamacc.org. The photograph is only required for the original nomination packet, not for the two (2) copies.

The criterion for Corporate Hispanic Business Advocate of the Year is as follows:

1. Be currently active with a Chamber/Organization, which is a member in good standing of TAMACC.
2. Submit a letter from the nominating Chamber/Organization certifying the nominee is a corporate sponsor for the Chamber/Organization.
3. Provide a description of accomplishments in procurement with Hispanic businesses and/or diversity programs.
4. Provide a description of partnering with the Chamber/Organization.
5. Other major accomplishment of the nominee in promoting and fostering the growth and prosperity of Hispanic businesses.
